Isaiah 61:1-3

The Year of the Lord's Favor

61 The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me,
because the Lord has anointed me
to bring good news to the poor;^[a]
he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted,
to proclaim liberty to the captives,
and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;^[b]
² to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor,
and the day of vengeance of our God;
to comfort all who mourn;
³ to grant to those who mourn in Zion—
to give them a beautiful headdress instead of ashes,
the oil of gladness instead of mourning,
the garment of praise instead of a faint spirit;
that they may be called oaks of righteousness,
the planting of the Lord, that he may be glorified.

Isaiah 53:4-5

Surely he has borne our griefs
and carried our sorrows;
yet we esteemed him stricken,
smitten by God, and afflicted.
⁵ But he was pierced for our transgressions;
he was crushed for our iniquities;
upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace,
and with his wounds we are healed.



Matthew 26:1-16

The Plot to Kill Jesus

26 When Jesus had finished all these sayings, he said to his disciples,
2 “You know that after two days the Passover is coming, and the Son
of Man will be delivered up to be crucified.”

3 Then the chief priests and the elders of the people gathered in the
palace of the high priest, whose name was Caiaphas, 4 and plotted
together in order to arrest Jesus by stealth and kill him. 5 But they said,
“Not during the feast, lest there be an uproar among the people.”

Jesus Anointed at Bethany

6 Now when Jesus was at Bethany in the house of Simon the leper,^[a] 7
a woman came up to him with an alabaster flask of very expensive
ointment, and she poured it on his head as he reclined at table. 8 And
when the disciples saw it, they were indignant, saying, “Why this
waste? 9 For this could have been sold for a large sum and given to
the poor.” 10 But Jesus, aware of this, said to them, “Why do you
trouble the woman?

For she has done a beautiful thing to me. 11 For you always have the
poor with you, but you will not always have me. 12 In pouring this
ointment on my body, she has done it to prepare me for burial. 13
Truly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is proclaimed in the whole
world, what she has done will also be told in memory of her.”

Judas to Betray Jesus

14 Then one of the twelve, whose name was Judas Iscariot, went to the
chief priests 15 and said, “What will you give me if I deliver him over to
you?” And they paid him thirty pieces of silver. 16 And from that
moment he sought an opportunity to betray him.
