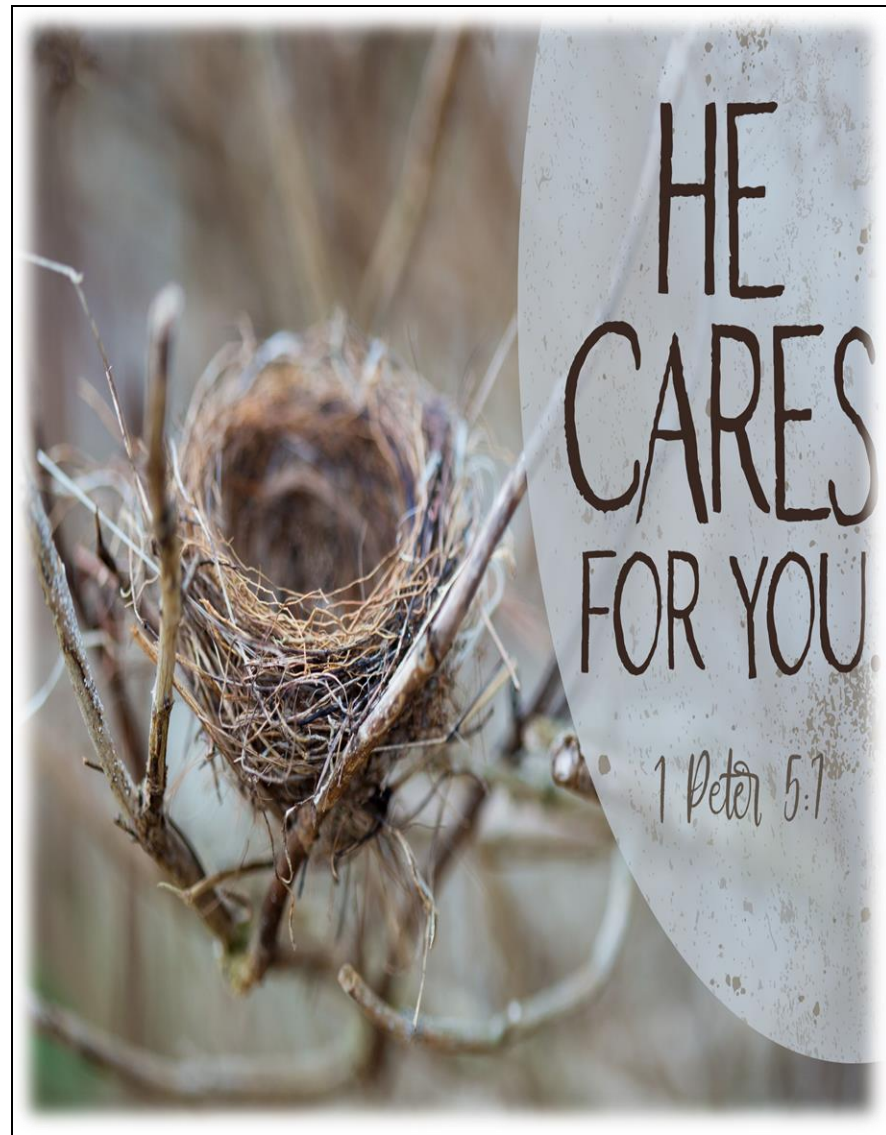
New Members Class - Saturday, June 3, 2023

FOOD DRIVE FOR GRIMSBY BENEVOLENT FUND

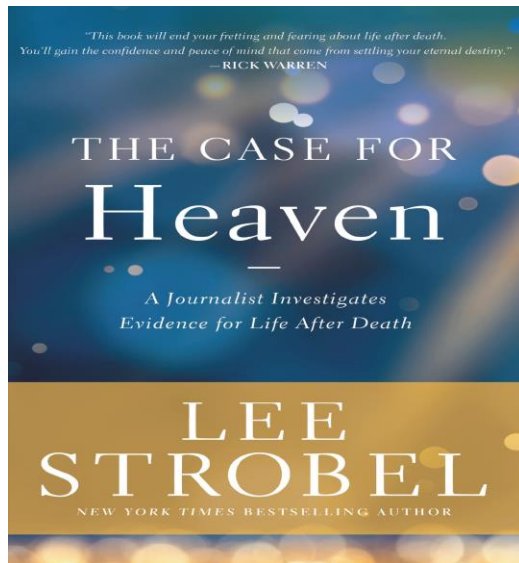

The Grimsby Benevolent Fund is currently greatly in need of non-perishable food items and monetary donations to meet the needs of those in our community. Here is a list of non-perishable food and other household items urgently needed at GBF:

Children's School Snacks - cookies, granola bars, fruit snacks, crackers
Beverages - tea, coffee
Condiments - ketchup, mustard, relish, mayonnaise, oil
Packages of pasta and rice
Canned fruit, pudding cups, applesauce cups
Household Cleaning Products - laundry and dish detergent, multipurpose cleaners
Baby Food and Diapers - Sizes 4, 5, 6, 4T-5T and Good Nights

NEW WEDNESDAY EVENING BIBLE STUDY



A new Wednesday evening Bible study will be starting Wednesday, June 7th at 7:00 p.m. “Bestselling and award-winning author Lee Strobel interviews experts about the evidence for the afterlife and offers credible answers to the most provocative questions about what happens when we die, near-death experiences, heaven, and hell. Looking at biblical accounts, Strobel unfolds what awaits us after we take our last breath and answers questions like:

- Is there an afterlife?
- What is heaven like?
- How will we spend our time there?
- And what does it mean to see God face to face?

With a balanced approach, Strobel examines the alternative of Hell and the logic of damnation, and gives a careful look at reincarnation, universalism, the exclusivity claims of Christ, and other issues related to the topic of life after death.”
