- 1. Luke 2:10-11 (ESV) "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord."
- 2. Isaiah 60:20 (ESV) "Your sun shall no more go down, nor your moon withdraw itself; for the Lord will be your everlasting light, and your days of mourning shall be ended."
- 3. Revelation 21:5 (ESV) "And he who was seated on the throne said, 'Behold, I am making all things new."
- 4. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (ESV) "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come."
- 5. Ecclesiastes 9:7 (ESV) "Go, eat your bread with joy, and drink your wine with a merry heart, for God has already approved what you do."
- 6. Hebrews 4:16 (ESV) "Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need."
