SUMMER INTERN JOB OPPORTUNITIES

We are excited that we have two summer student positions available this summer for our children and youth ministry. These positions are funded primarily by the Federal government as part of the Canada Summer Jobs program. Those who would be interested in serving the children and youth of our church and community must be currently between the ages of 15-30, be in full-time studies, and be returning to full-time studies in the fall. Both positions are for 30 hours a week for 7 weeks. The first position is for a **summer programs coordinator**. The second is for a **technology coordinator and administrator**.
