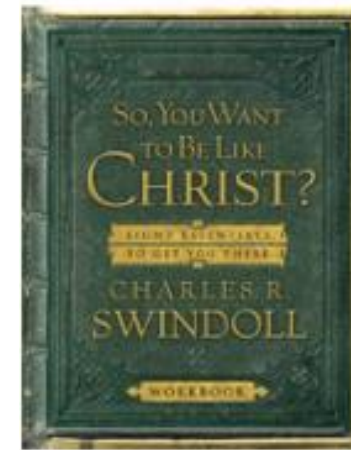

Community Support Services of Niagara (CSSN) is a volunteer based not-for profit agency providing comprehensive client-driven community support services across the Niagara Region to help seniors and adults with disabilities live independently in their own homes. Services offered include: Meals on Wheels, Congregate Dining, Transportation, Homemaking, Friendly Visiting, Security Phone Calls, Safety at Home, Leaf and Snow Buddies, Home Maintenance and Repair.

Studies have shown that older adults are more likely to have feelings of loneliness and isolation. The lack of supportive social network is linked to negative health conditions, increase in the risk of dementia and cognitive decline and a higher risk of hospitalization.

CSSN offers a Security and Reassurance Phone Chat program whereby clients are called daily. The intended purpose of this daily phone call is to check on an individual's well being and lessen the effects of loneliness and isolation.
