At Teen Challenge, they believe that God is the catalyst for change for people with life-controlling drug and alcohol problems. They believe that a balance of love, accountability and training are required to prepare the individual for successful re-entry into society.

In 1958, Pastor David Wilkerson reached out to troubled street youth in New York City. Teen Challenge was created to meet the needs of these youth and has spread literally around the world.

Originally located in Hamilton, Ontario, Teen Challenge London was established in 1991 when a nursing home set on 46 acres in London became available.
